HINCKLEY & BOSWORTH COMMUNITY TRANSPORT SCHEME

Hinckley and Bosworth Community Transport is a charity which began in 1988.

Its purpose is to provide community transport for the elderly and disabled population in the Hinckley & Bosworth area therefore reducing social isolation and maintaining and improving their quality of life.

Currently our minibus is self-funded by way of charges made to passengers/groups and fundraising.

The vehicle is designed to take into consideration the needs of the elderly and disabled as detailed below:

- Our vehicle is a Mercedes 16 Seater (plus driver)
- It will carry 1 wheelchair (non transferrable passenger) which can be clamped but this does lower the seating capacity by 2 seats
- We are able to carry foldable wheelchairs and walkers although this may reduce the seating capacity.
- There is low floor access and we have a hydraulic tail lift which makes boarding easier if required.

Our driver is fully trained and is experienced working with the elderly and disabled.

Groups wishing to use the minibus will be provided with a driver and will be charged an hourly and mileage rate.

We will be only too pleased to offer ideas for suitable destinations for group visits, organise regular shopping and lunch trips etc.
